Well if two players are of equal skill and one is using the clear scope whereas the other isn't, then technically it's going to give the former an advantage. However, as it has already been pointed out, it's not much of an advantage since your ability to aim isn't augmented in any way... only how much of the surrounding area you can see while zoomed in.

While some people may feel that any advantage that one person can get over another is a form of cheating, the playing field is always going to be somewhat uneven with regards to the different hardware the players are running the game on, their internet connection, etc. I'm not saying that this is the same as the slight advantage one player may have over another due to a better framerate, because it isn't. The comparison that I'm trying to draw between the two is that on the whole, the outcome of the game is not really going to be altered by these kinds of small differences between players. I would frown upon using a clear scope myself, but to ban people from servers for something that gives more aesthetic advantages to the user than anything else smells of a witch hunt to me.

I think it's a cheat. And so is anything else that modifies the game to your advantage, in my opinion. The guestion is, when does a cheat become "too much"? Even beacon countdown mods were compared to cheating once they showed up (though not by many, but nevertheless), and now it's available in CP1, and accepted next to completely.

There's no answer to this, it's just about everyone's personal opinion. The clear field of the "crystal scope" is too much in my opinion, I don't mind the tint. On the other hand, players who play with 1600*1200 resolution can see TWICE as much as those who play with 800*600. That is clearly even a bigger issue than the clear scope, but nobody even considers it a cheat.

I would consider it as a minor cheat. Not allowed in Pure Mode, especially in clanmatches and other tournaments, but ok in public games. Just like the way it is.
