Since I have an extensive library of C&C 3D models, I looked into Shapeways as a viable place to set up shop and start selling some of the designs I've created. They handle all of the work that I don't feel like doing (shipping, payment handling, etc) and all I do is create the work for sale.

I'm starting with the GDI logo. I've created a pendant out of it. You'll need your own necklace chain, but those aren't hard to get. I'm also looking into developing keychains, bracelets, and desk trinkets in addition to recreating the GDI/Nod pin set.

I'll get a Nod pendant up soon. There's a lot of adjustments I need to make to that particular model to make it print-worthy. It's also possible to print out scale models of the C&C items I've built, so you can have a pretty accurate rendition of any of your favorite buildings or vehicles. I might even look into having my Mammoth Tank turned into a printable model with textures applied. Let me know what you think, and if there's any kind of model you'd like to see turned into a print.

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Well, the good news is that the prints should be orderable now. The GDI pendant had some issues with being too small in a few areas, so I rescaled it and ordered it and the Nod pendant so I can show them on the store.

I'd like more ideas for products, so feel free to drop some ideas. I was thinking of taking some of the TD buildings I had created and turning them into scale models. They wouldn't be huge unless you really wanted to pay a decent amount of money for them. Once they get bigger than three inches, the cost increases exponentially. For example, the textured GDI logo ( http://shpws.me/neio ) at 2.5 inches costs \$20 in sandstone. If you pushed it to 5 inches, it jumps to \$100.
