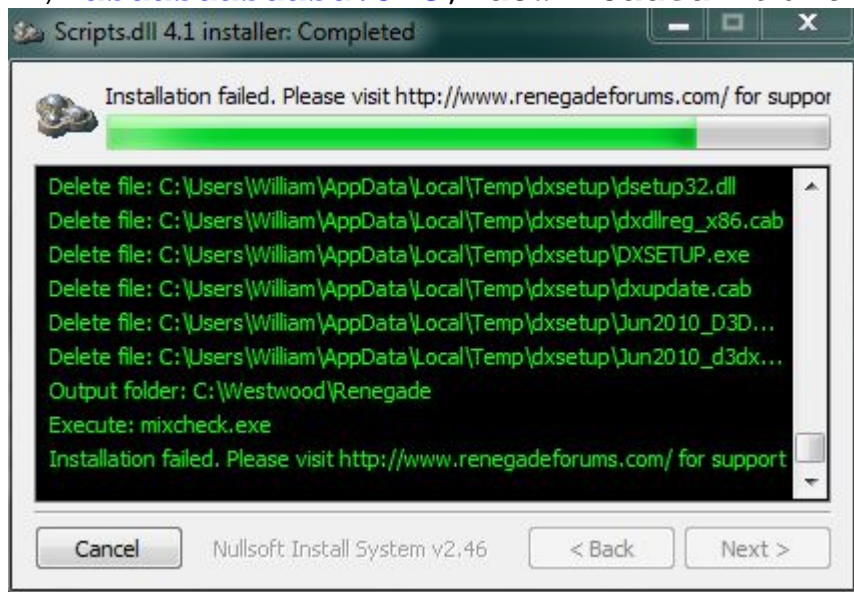
I get this error now below

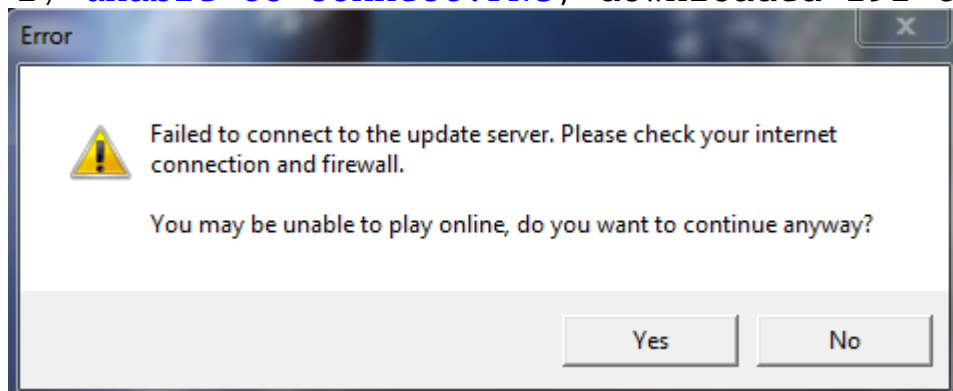
