Edit: just to be more specific:

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS - YOU MUST READ THIS IN ORDER TO PLAY THE
MODIFICATION: Go into your C:\Westwood\Renegade directory. Rename the Scripts.dll file to Scripts2.dll. Take the Scripts.dll file in this zip archive and extract it into your C:\Westwood\Renegade folder. Then extract the RedAlertMod.pkg file into your Renegade\data directory and play as you normally would.

I followed the instruction and it still don't work.
I'll just try again incase its my comp.

Renegade Alert comes in a .exe installer, and the mod is in .mix format, and is installed to it's own folder seperate from the Renegade folder (C:\Westwood\RenAlert). The mod hasn't been in the .pkg format in a .zip for many releases.

You need to go here: http://dynamic.gamespy.com/~renalert/content/old/downloads_patches.php and download either the .993 full installer, or the .991 installer and each patch up to .993 and install them in order.
