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I've seen a Renegade CD break it happens more than you think. If I were you I would try to do it in these steps.

- 1# uninstall Renguard or what's left of it
- 2# uninstall Renegade
- 3# Delete all remaining folders C:/Ren directory
- 4# go to CMD type regedit or just run > regedit.

Search for Renegade & Westwood Delete all keys.

Reboot.

Go to taskmanager and delete all unnecessary processes.

Put in the Renegade CD, Install.

Have the 1037 patch ready on your desktop before all of this.

Install the patch. Try to run it now with CD first.

If that doesn't work Install DJlaptops NOCD.
