Yeah, it is. The graphics are outdated, as you would expect for a PS2 game that old, and the AI isn't flawless, but I haven't set the difficulty on the bot matches up high yet. The game has a bot match mode, one and two players, a campaign mode, one player only, and an Internet play mode, both one and two players. I never played the Internet mode before, as I didn't have an Internet connection to my PS2, but I surmise it's pretty fun.

You can customize your character before you start the game, getting skins from two different Bio-Durm soldiers and around 4 or 5 human skins, both male and female for the humans. There are several game types: Deathmatch, Team Deathmatch, Capture The Flag, one kinda like the Domination mode out of the first Unreal Tournament, if you've ever played that, and I think a few more.

The campaign is fun, but a little difficult for me, as the third mission, which I'm currently on, you're by yourself completely and on a time limit.

Overall, I would give the game a 8.4 out of 10, myself.
