Take into consideration that when you over clock the cpu you're also overclocking the RAM. Now if you have cheapo RAM I really wouldn't push your luck by going any higher.

I have a AMD Sempron 3300+ and its stock rate is 1.80GHz. I'm currently running mine at 2.2Ghz. I've seen a site where someone with my chip has gone to 2.5Ghz with standard cooling. But the difference there is that I have cheap ram rated at DDR333 (165mhz@stock) which are now hitting 196mhz so nearly DDR400. My computer is stable for normal working condition; I'm playing Renegade but when I start doing some video decoding/encoding I can get the BSOD. So be careful with what you overclock.
