try this to see if it makes your problem go away.

Open regedit (go to start then run then type regedit).

Go to HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE and then Software and then RenGuard.

Check for the PatchVersion entry, if it is not there or it is 0 and you have Core Patch 1 installed, create the entry as a new DWORD value (if it is not there) and set it to 1.

If you do not have Core Patch 1 installed, delete the entry (if its there) or set it to 0.

I've tried that but it's still not working. I still have Old files does not exist.
