If it's BSOD'ing on Prime95, then chances are there isn't enough voltage going to the CPU. You need to up the CPU voltage a bit in order to make it stable.

If you don't want to add more voltage then you need to either turn down the multiplier a bit, or take a chance with a system that isn't 100% stable. If you keep your current settings and play a game, you may crash.
