If there is no Game.exe in the RenAlert folder, you installed it wrong.

Here's how I finally got .992 to work:

- 1. Make a folder somewhere called RenAlertWinRAR.
- 2. Download .991, .9915, and .992 installers into the newly created folder.
- 3. Install .991 into C:\Westwood\RenAlert, I think RenAlert doesn't like being anywhere but this directory.
- 4. Now, patch .991 to .9915. This is very simple just double-click on the installer.
- 5. NOW, double-click on the .992 patch until you get the screen to select the Game.exe file. Here, navigate to C:\Westwood\RenAlert and locate the Game.exe file in that folder. Now patch that file.
- 6. You might have to do this, might not. Go to the Start Menu and click on Run... Now, type in regedit and follow this path: HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE --> SOFTWARE --> Westwood --> RenAlert and click on Version in that folder. Now, make sure the version number is set to 1.

After that, RenAlert should run in .992.
