One is for WWW. Renguard.com and one is for http://www.renguard.net. Both programs instantly attempt to load some interesting spyware. In fact one of them tried to change my IE start-up page from my default. Thank God, for Spybot!!!! Since, visiting those sites, my DsI is in nearly constant activity, and I got a message (unconfirmed as to cause) to check my paypal account because somebody (could have been me since i recently upgraded to GS founder) tried to access my account.

Well, I felt these issues were serious enough to send you a post. Please let me know what you find out, and how I can run RG so it does not corrupt things Incidentally, I am running Windows XP, if that helps. Thanks Mark AKA Attaraxus
