You can use DAEMON tools to make your computer think that it has more CD drives than it actually has, so that the .iso file acts as a CD in a CD/DVD drive. Using that, you'll be able to install WOL, though you need a serial code...

Or you could just try unzipping this, and putting it in your SUN/Internet folder. I don't know if it'll work though.
