I don't have a serial number so I saw the sticky and tried to use the 0069 trick but it didnt work. It says Next at the bottom but it wasnt clickable. I entered 0069 followed by 18 random numbers. If it did this wrong please tell me, and tell me how to do it right. Or just if you how i can solve this then just reply. I attached a screenshot of what it looks like, so any help would be greatly appreciated.

Also, a random serial won't work anymore as XWIS requires a valid serial for servers now. You can use that trick to install it, but then you will have to open server.ini and change the serial to match your Renegade game cd serial key (these are also now valid server serials on XWIS, but you can't use them to install the FDS)
