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PlanetSide is a game that appeals to a lot of Renegade players. It's an MMOFPS in which three empires struggle for control of multiple "continents" each of which contain multiple bases that must be captured and held. In terms of teamwork oriented gameplay, PlanetSide has all other games beat. In a nutshell, I would say it's very much like other FPS games, but with the strategy of an RTS, and the size of an RPG.

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For those that have tried it and got bored of it after a couple days, you most likely didn't get involved in an outfit, and therefore didn't get the whole game experience. PlanetSide offers a level of teamplay not possible in ANY other game available, mostly through outfits and outfit alliances, but sometimes empire-wide as well.

For example, here are some pictures of an armor raid my outfit did just last night:

At times we had over 25 tanks on the battlefield with air cover, anti-air support, and a repair/rearming station. Other times we had around 12 2-man main battle tanks, or 11 3-man bombing aircraft, or 20 artillery units shelling a base from over a kilometer away. The artillery also had anti-air support, and cloakers closer to the base "lazer-pointing" out targets for us to hit.

You just can't, and won't see anything like that in any other game. It is well worth my \$15.

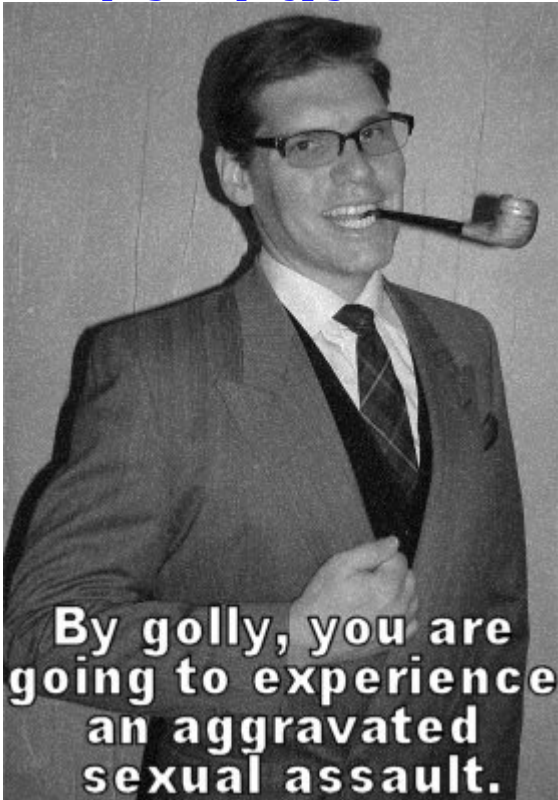
