You have the red card, and the mission pogo in the top right for the captain is missing, which means it should have been completed, yet the text message still says you need to kill him for the card. I don't remember sequence breaking ever being a problem in this level, and I'm not sure if it would even be a problem. What I do see in both screenshots is that the prisoners appear to be stuck in place. When that happened to me, I had to try to push them around a bit, or hit E on them and hope they did something. If they won't move at all anymore, you won't be able to finish the mission, so you'll need to load an earlier save.
