I have a TV card on my computer. I hook my TV card up to my VCR. I output the computer's video and sound signals to the VCR. I record the game on a VCR video tape.

By recording games through a VCR tape, your computer's processor does not get lagged down as it would via another method like FRAPS. You can record games at normal gameplay FPS this

way.

After the content is on videotape, I simply route the VCR's output signal and connect it to the computer/TV card's input signal. I then use TV card software to record what the VCR is playing.

It's a multistep process but I think it's better than FRAPS for any users without a powerhouse of a computer.
